¹Direct Subsidy Scheme Schools Council (DSSSC)

The Hong Kong Direct Subsidy Scheme Schools Council (DSSSC) serves as a key liaison between Direct Subsidy Scheme (DSS) schools and the Education Bureau (EDB). It plays a vital role in shaping policy, facilitates communication, and promotes best practices. While DSS schools enjoy greater autonomy in curriculum and fees, they remain under government supervision. As of the 2025/26 school year, there are 78 schools operating under the Direct Subsidy Scheme (DSS) in Hong Kong. It total consists of 57 secondary schools and 21 primary schools.

²Hong Kong Productivity Council (HKPC)

The Hong Kong Productivity Council (HKPC) is a statutory body established in 1967 dedicated to enhancing the productivity and competitiveness of Hong Kong enterprises. It drives "new industrialisation," smart manufacturing, and technological innovation (R&D) to support businesses in Hong Kong and the Greater Bay Area, serving as a key facilitator of digital transformation and sustainability.

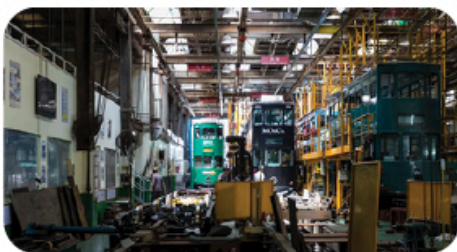
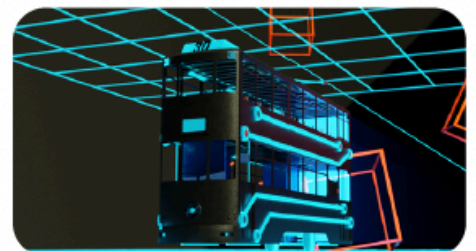

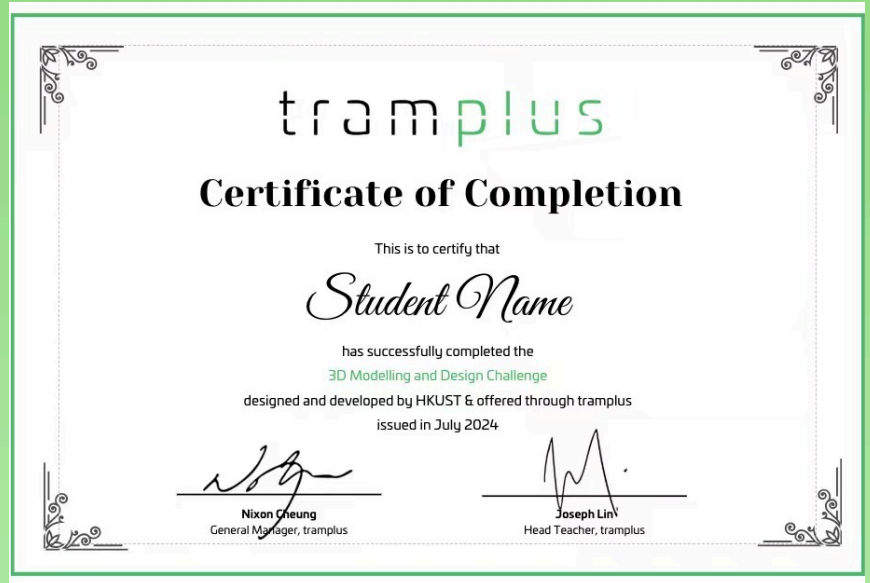
